### Visit to Orange Tree Theatre – Year 8

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Orange Tree Theatre on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2023. The aim of this visit is to give students the opportunity to watch a performance of Romeo and Juliet, which they have spent autumn term studying. It will be a great chance for the students to conceptualise the text as a play and see Shakespeare's craft come to life!

Students will leave the school at 1pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> December 2023 and travel by coach to and from the Orange Tree Theatre, Richmond, returning to school at 5pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black leather like shoes. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

The expectation is that everyone will attend because this is linked closely to the school curriculum and will assist their learning.

The cost of this trip is £30.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £30.00, before Thursday, 30<sup>th</sup> November 2023. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to [finance@uhs.org.uk](mailto:finance@uhs.org.uk).
