

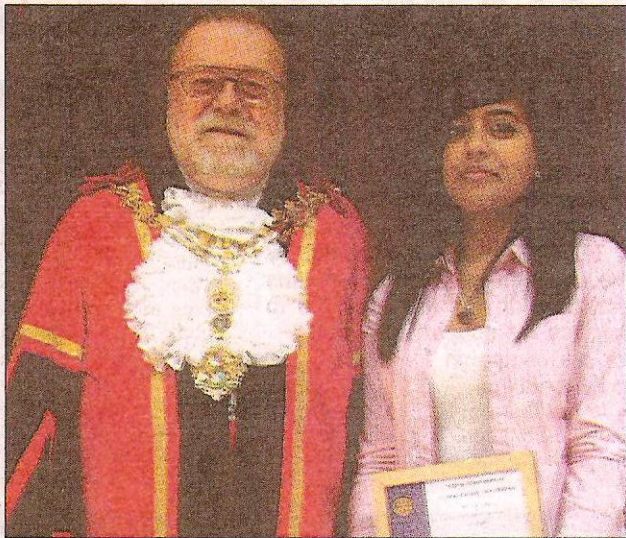
Honoured for caring for her mum

A SIXTH-FORM pupil whose mother has cancer has been honoured for researching treatment to try to improve her condition.
