

Proposed Change to Admissions Policy

September 2013

It is proposed that the Published Admissions Number (PAN) be increased from 210 to 230 to reflect a change in the oversubscription criteria as follows:

1. Children in Public Care as defined by the Children Act 1989
2. Children who currently have a brother or sister* as a pupil on roll at Uxbridge High School and who would reasonably be expected to still be attending at Uxbridge High School at the time of admission.

3. Aptitude:

Football

Children identified by Brentford Football Club, as showing aptitude in football. (Priority will be given to a maximum of 10 students on the basis of aptitude in football).

Music

Children selected on the basis of aptitude for music as measured by the school's aptitude assessment procedures. (Priority will be given to a maximum of 10 students on the basis of aptitude in music).

Applicants applying under the Football criterion will be required to provide a letter from Brentford Football Club to confirm they are a full member of Brentford Academy.

Applicants applying under the Music criterion will be required to complete an aptitude assessment and perform a single piece on their chosen instrument or vocally.

Parents applying under the Aptitude criteria must contact the school for further details and a Supplementary Information Form.

4. Children living nearest the School (measured in a straight line from the School Office to their parents' permanent home as set by Ordnance Survey points of reference**).

* This does not include cousins or other family members who live in the same household, but will include stepbrothers/sisters and foster children.

** This must be that of the child's permanent home with his/her parents or legal guardians.

Timeline

5th January 2012

- Consultation on change in criteria starts, as determined by the Admissions Code and the Secretary of State

1st March 2012

- Consultation End Date

15th April 2012

- Admission Arrangements determined for admissions in September 2013
