16-19 TUITION FUND

What is the catch-up premium?

Children and young people across the country have experienced unprecedented disruption to their education as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19). Those from the most vulnerable and disadvantaged backgrounds will be among those hardest hit. The premium is to provide small group tutoring activity for disadvantaged 16 to 19 students whose studies have been disrupted as a result of coronavirus (COVID-19).

Intended outcome

Support students to achieve a grade 4 in English and maths and to provide students to catch up with content missed through lost teaching over the previous months. Curriculum areas to identify skills and knowledge gaps to provide additional tuition for students.

How is impact measured?

Data captures will take place in the autumn term and again in the spring. This will measure how close students are to achieving their minimum expected grades. Results from the November series of examinations will be used to measure impact with students re-taking English and mathematics.

Implementation

Learners will be identified following early assessments then interventions put in place. Tutoring will begin for students re-sitting English and maths in the November series. Students in year 12 have been identified with gaps in knowledge,

The funding will be used to:

- Provide catch up tuition for students who require a grade 4 in English and maths;
- Provide extra support through 1:1 tutoring;
- Provide additional time for students to complete practical work such as science practical's.

Provision

Most provision will be provided by teachers within the school. Catch up lessons have been provided online during half term holidays and after school in the autumn term. Groups are limited, with a maximum of 5 students. Students who receive bursary or pupil premium are prioritised.
