Visit to Brunel University – Year 9

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Brunel University on Monday 14th October. The aim of this visit is for students to take part in the Target Mars workshop. Students will develop an understanding of how to survive on mars and life on board a space station.

Students will leave the school at 08:40 on Monday 14th October and walk to and from Brunel University, returning to school at 15:30. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch for this trip. Students will also require a pencil case, filled with a pen, pencil, ruler, rubber and calculator.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.
