Dear Parent

Visit to London – Year 11

I am writing to inform you about a GCSE German revision conference in London on Monday 11th March. The aim of this visit is to provide students with in-depth and practical revision and exam techniques to enable greater success in their exams. They will have the chance to speak to a GCSE examiner as well as working in groups to practice all four exam skills, including top techniques for the speaking exam, which they will take just over a month later.

Students will meet at Uxbridge Station at 8:30am on Monday 11th March and will travel by train to and from London, returning to Uxbridge at 4:00pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform including shoes, will need a packed lunch for the trip and will also need to bring a notebook or their German exercise book and a pen. Please ensure that your child brings a coat and umbrella with them if the weather is cold or wet and that their oyster card is topped up.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £25. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £25, before Monday 11th February. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals or payment would present a problem, please contact Miss Goddard.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
