Visit to Twitter Head Office – Year 10

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Twitter Head Office on Tuesday 15th October. The aim of this visit is for computer science students to take part in a workshop where they will learn how to create a website and app.

Students will leave the school at 09:30 on Tuesday 15th October and travel by train to and from the Twitter Head Office, returning to school at 15:30. Please ensure your child has a valid zip/oyster card, topped up with funds sufficient for this journey. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Lunch will be provided by Twitter.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.
