### **Visit to the Clinical Hypnotherapy Centre and Imperial War Museum – Year 12 & 13**

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Clinical Hypnotherapy Centre and Imperial War Museum on Friday 7<sup>th</sup> February. At the clinical hypnosis centre, students will gain an understanding of ways in which psychologists treat phobias. This is part of the psychopathology specification within A Level paper 1. In the afternoon, students will visit the Imperial War Museum to gain a greater understanding of what inspired Stanley Milgram to lead research into obedience. By gaining a deeper understanding, this will assist students in completing the social influence section of the exam.

The trip will last the full day and full timings will be released closer to the event. Students will meet Mr Tattersall and Mr Baichande at the Clinical Hypnotherapy Centre, where we will have a two hour session exploring phobias, before having lunch and moving onto the Imperial War Museum. Students will be dismissed from the Imperial War Museum to make their own way home. Students will be required to wear smart, professional dress, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require either a packed lunch for this trip or money to purchase lunch near the venue. Students will be required to bring a pen and notebook.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £30.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £30.00, before Friday 6<sup>th</sup> December.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
