### **Visit to Shakespeare on Trial – Years 12 & 13**

I am writing to inform you about an opportunity for your child to participate in the 'Shakespeare on Trial' course. This three-day course will run from Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> September to Friday 27<sup>th</sup> September and will be held at Shakespeare's Globe Theatre, the National Justice Museum and Brunel University. Students participating in the course will develop confidence in public speaking and awareness of legal procedures, as well as critical thinking, analysing evidence, ordering ideas and presenting information.

Students will make their own way to and from each of the venues. Students will be required to wear smart dress, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch for days one and two of the course. However, lunch will be provided by the venue on day three of the course. An agenda will be provided to students prior to the event.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

There is no cost for this trip however, please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible.

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency
