Design and Technology Contribution Request

During the course of this year, your child will be making a variety of items as part of their lessons, many of which they will be able to bring home and keep. These items will be made from consumable materials, electronic components and resistant materials. Due to funding changes in recent years, we are unable to continue to provide such a range of experiences without your help. Therefore, to help cover the cost of these materials and to ensure that students have access to good quality materials and equipment, each year the technology department will be asking parents for a voluntary contribution of £5.

Your contribution will allow students to be more creative and use a wider range of materials, and serves to encourage students to take more care with their work and not waste materials. The contribution will also enable the DT department to continue to provide a variety of opportunities for students to make and take home products that they design, and will enable us to invest funds in new equipment.

Please note that students will still be asked to bring ingredients in for food technology lessons.

If parents are unable to make a contribution, materials will still be provided by the department, but in these circumstances your child may be unable to bring the finished item home.
