Visit to The Emmanuel Centre – Year 12 &13

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to The Emmanuel Centre on Friday 20th March. We are delighted to be able to offer sixth form psychology students the chance to attend the Dr Zimbardo conference at the Emmanuel Centre. Dr Zimbardo is one of the key psychologists students study for their A Level paper 1 exam and ran the famous Stanford University Prison Experiment. This is a unique opportunity to hear him discuss key areas of psychology live. Other presenters at the conference include Cara Flanagan, who writes the textbooks for AQA and has been an A Level examiner.

The conference will last the full day and full timings will be released closer to the event. Students must meet Mr Tattersall and Mr Baichande at The Emmanuel Centre, London, SW1P 3DW and will be dismissed directly from the venue at the end of the conference. Students will be required to wear smart, professional dress, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will be required to bring a pen and notebook and should either bring a packed lunch or money to purchase lunch near the venue.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

The conference is extremely popular and there are a limited number of places reserved, which will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. However, it is vital that students confirm their attendance no later than Monday 2nd December. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £22.50. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £22.50, before Friday 17th January.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
