Visit to ExCel London – Year 12

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to ExCel London on Friday 15th November. The aim of this visit is to attend the Skills London 2019 convention. This is a brilliant opportunity for your child and we highly recommend that they attend.

Skills London is the biggest interactive jobs and careers event for young people in London. Aimed at Year 12 students, this fantastic event offers the opportunity to interact with some of the best names in employment, education and training in a highly interactive and inspirational environment. Students are offered a real insight into the world of work, a chance to try out new skills and activities, and gain impartial advice about global opportunities.

Students will travel to and from ExCel London unaccompanied. The exhibition starts at 12:00 and will finish at 14:00. Students should leave school at 10am and travel to ExCel London to ensure they arrive on time. Students should enter the venue using doors N5 or N6. Please ensure that your child has enough money on their Oyster card for the return journey. Students will be provided with directions and an emergency contact number for the day.

Students are required to wear smart business clothing including shoes, no trainers or jeans to be worn. Students will be required to bring a packed lunch with them.

If your child suffers from Asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

There is no cost for this trip however, please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible.
