Visit to eMagazine Student Conference – Year 12

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the eMagazine Student Conference on Wednesday 16th October. This conference will stretch A Level English students. Many of the talks will feed directly into their NEA coursework at the end of this academic year. Students will also engage in university-style lectures and experience lecture spaces. A number of prolific lecturers from London universities will be presenting, posing opportunities for students to network directly with faculty members of potential university placements.

Students will leave the school at 08:40 on Wednesday 16th October and travel by train to and from the eMagazine, Euston, returning to school at 16:50. Please ensure your child has a valid oyster/zip card loaded with funds sufficient for this journey. Students will be required to wear smart, professional dress, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £22.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £22.00, before Monday 30th September.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
