### **Visit to Women in Black, Fortune Theatre – Years 10 & 11**

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to watch Women in Black at the Fortune Theatre on Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> November. The aim of this visit is for students to watch a live performance for component 3 of their GCSE.

Students will leave the school at 13:00 on Tuesday, 2<sup>nd</sup> November and travel by coach to and from the Fortune Theatre, returning to school at 18:15. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip. Students attending the visit will be asked by the theatre to provide verbal confirmation that they have tested negative for COVID-19 and do not have symptoms.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £28.63. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £28.63, before Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> October.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
