### **Visit to Apollo Theatre – Year 10, 11, 12 & 13**

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to the Apollo Theatre, Victoria on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> January. The aim of this visit is for students to watch a live performance of *Wicked* for their BTEC dance and drama courses.

Students will leave the school at 11:15 on Wednesday, 26<sup>th</sup> January and travel by London Underground to and from the Apollo Theatre, returning to Uxbridge Station at 19:00, where they will be dismissed. Students will require a valid zip/travel card, loaded with sufficient funds for the return journey. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch and plenty of drinks for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £20.51. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £20.51, before Monday, 8<sup>th</sup> November.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
