Dear parent/carer

Visit to Troubadour Theatre, Wembley – Year 12 & 13

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Troubadour Theatre, Wembley on Tuesday, 14th December 2021. The aim of this visit is to watch *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night Time*.

Year 13 will study *Frantic Assembly* after half term as they will be completing an external assessment in January which requires them to have studied and watched performance material from a chosen practitioner. This play is choreographed by Frantic Assembly and is the only performance in London at the moment by this company. The Year 12 course requires them to watch live theatre, this experience will enrich their study of performing arts.

Students will leave the school at 12:00 on Tuesday, 14th December 2021 and travel by London Underground to and from the Troubadour Theatre, returning to Uxbridge Station at approximately 17:15, where they will all be dismissed. Students will be required to wear smart, professional dress, including shoes (no trainers or jeans allowed). Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £25.00. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £25.00, before Friday, 26th November 2021.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the trip organiser.

By consenting on ParentPay to this trip, you agree to:

- Your child taking part in the visit as detailed above;
- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
