Dear Parent

We would like to invite your child to attend Uxbridge High School's summer school. We will be running the event for two full days from Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> August to Tuesday 24<sup>th</sup> August. The summer school is very popular and if you would like your child to attend, please book a place as soon as possible. As we were unable to provide an onsite school induction day in July, we strongly advise that all students sign up as it is an excellent opportunity for them to meet their peers and some teachers for the first time, which will help with their transition into Year 7.

The summer school aims to build confidence and provide an opportunity to make new friends before they start Uxbridge High School in September. The activities will range from team building and social activities, to experiencing different areas of the school curriculum. All of the activities will be designed for your child to learn from and, more importantly, enjoy.

**Timings:** On Monday, registration will begin at 08:00 with staggered start times and the day will finish for all students at 15:00. On Tuesday, registration for all students will be at 09:00 and the summer school will finish at 15:00. See below start times for Monday. The school will communicate to you in due course which House/form your child is in, which means you will know what time their registration begins.

**Registration and consent:** Please note that all students are required to have a negative lateral flow test prior to attending. For incoming Year 7s this means that a test will be undertaken on the first day of attendance. Students will take the test themselves, under the supervision and direction of an adult. By completing the consent form below, you are giving consent for your child to be tested. It is important to note that all students must have a consent form filled out prior to starting the summer school:

Your child will not be able to attend if we do not receive the above online form completed. For safeguarding purposes and emergencies, it is imperative that the information provided is accurate and contactable for the duration of the summer school.

**Food:** On both days, there will be a morning break and lunch. Students eligible for free school meals will be provided with a 'meal-deal' of a filled sandwich, a piece of fruit and a drink. Students who are not eligible for free school meals are encouraged to bring their own packed lunch. Meal deals from the school can also be purchased on site for a cost of £2.25 for which cash payments will be available on both days. Snacks will also be available for purchase on the day.

**Clothing:** Students should wear comfortable casual clothes and shoes or trainers. Uxbridge High School cannot take responsibility for any lost items and we therefore request that your child does **not** bring a large amount of money with them each day. They also will not be permitted to have mobile phones, music players, or any kind of gaming devices throughout the course of the two days.
