Visit to Wokingham Superbowl – Year 11

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Wokingham Superbowl on Wednesday, 15th December 2021. This is a rewards trip for Year 11 students. Students will get to enjoy a game of laser quest and bowling.

Students will leave the school at 12:45 on Wednesday, 15th December 2021 and travel by coach to and from the Wokingham Superbowl, returning to school at 17:00. Students will be required to wear school uniform but have comfortable change of clothes and training shoes, suitable for bowling and laser quest. Students will have time to eat their lunch before departure at 12:45. They may also bring snacks or money to buy snacks and drinks but they must not be eaten on the coach.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £20.12. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £20.12, before Friday 3rd December. Please note that by paying the non-refundable cost, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to finance@uhs.org.uk.

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
