



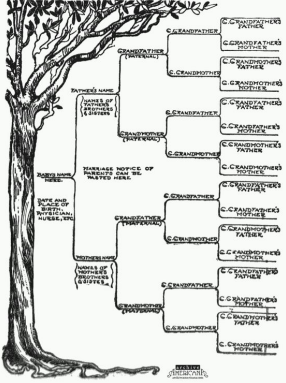

Task to be completed

1. Create a mind map on the theme '*Origins*'. You can explore areas such as; genesis, birth, dawn, beginning, creation, foundation, outset, emergence, cradle, launch, source, seed, germ, commencement.
- Origin definition: 1. The point or place where something begins, arises, or is derived. 2. The more fixed end or attachment of a muscle.
2. Your topic is open and completely up to you.
 3. Collect 30 photographs to support your research
 4. Complete 10 sketches in a material of your choice. These sketches need to support your theme.
 5. Write out a paragraph on your intended theme and why you have selected it.
 6. You should complete a gallery visit that links to your idea. You must collect evidence such as photos, receipts, leaflets and sketches, and then present them.
