Visit to Beck Theatre Sleeping Beauty Pantomime – Year 07

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Beck Theatre Sleeping Beauty Pantomime on Monday 15th December 2025. The purpose of this visit is to support students' learning in drama, particularly physical theatre and commedia dell'arte and to give them valuable exposure to live music and performance. It will also help prepare them for the GCSE Drama live theatre evaluation and provide a positive bonding activity for Year 7 before the winter break.

Students will leave the school at 10:15am on 15th December 2025 and travel by coach to Beck Theatre, returning to school at 1:45pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform and carry a packed lunch for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available, and these will be allocated on a first come, first basis.

The cost of this trip is £23. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable deposit of £9 and the remaining amount of £14 by Wednesday 10th December 2025. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip. The cost of the ticket includes an ice-cream at the interval, coach travel and the entrance to the show.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use your Arbor Parent Portal to pay for this trip. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to finance@uhs.org.uk.
