### **Visit to Hampton Court Palace – Year 7**

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Hampton Court Palace on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026. Henry VIII is taught as part of the history curriculum and this visit will provide students contextual understanding of Elizabeth I ready for Year 8.

Students will leave the school at 9am on Wednesday, 24<sup>th</sup> June 2026 and travel by coach to and from the Hampton Court Palace, returning to school at 3.30pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black leather-like shoes. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

Please note that there are a limited number of places available and these will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. Only students with an exemplary record of behaviour will be eligible. This visit will only take place if we have a sufficient number of students and confirmed payments.

The cost of this trip is £19. If you would like your child to participate in this trip, please pay the non-refundable cost of £19, before Friday, 1<sup>st</sup> May 2026. Please note that by paying the non-refundable deposit, you are agreeing for your child to attend this trip.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use your Arbor Parent Portal to pay for this trip. If your child receives free school meals and payment should present a problem, please contact the finance team via email to [finance@uhs.org.uk](mailto:finance@uhs.org.uk).
