Visit to The Lyceum Theatre – GCSE Drama Year 10

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to The Lyceum Theatre on Wednesday, 18th March 2026. The aim of this visit is to offer an enriching experience for the students as they experience a professional West End Production. Any exposure to the elements of theatre will be highly beneficial to our GCSE Drama students as they will be evaluating a piece of live theatre in their component 3 exam in May 2027. As well as this they will be able to see the vast array of career options available within the industry of theatre and entertainment.

Students will leave the school at 12:45pm on Wednesday, 18th March 2026 and travel by coach to and from The Lyceum Theatre, returning to school between 6:45pm and 7:00pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform. Students will require a packed lunch for this trip.

If your child suffers from asthma or requires an EpiPen, it is your responsibility to ensure that the appropriate medication is provided for this trip.

There will be no cost for the trip as we believe exposure to live theatre is a compulsory element to the GCSE Drama course. However, we would be grateful for a £10 voluntary contribution towards the cost of the coach, there will be an option on Arbor to do this.

- A member of staff giving consent for your child to receive appropriate medical treatment in the event of an emergency.
