### Visit to Warner Brothers Studios – Year 9

I am writing to inform you about a school visit to Warner Brothers Studios in Watford on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024. Students will find out information on making films, which is a big part of the UK business industry, and their young minds will be stimulated as they discover the extraordinary artistry, technology and talent that went into creating the Harry Potter film series.

Students will leave the school at 1.40pm on Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> March 2024 and travel by coach to and from the Warner Brothers studios, returning to school at 6.30pm. Students will be required to wear school uniform, including black leather-look shoes.

As the school no longer accepts cash or cheques, parents are asked to use ParentPay to pay for this trip. If you are unable to pay online, please contact the school office, who will provide a barcode letter to enable payment at a PayPoint, which is linked to your ParentPay account.
