

Reflection Space


The Reflection Space is a free and open space for any students who need a quiet and safe area. It is open every lunchtime from 1:20 - 1:50 and we have students who come to relax, pray, meditate, play a quiet game or just read, draw or make origami.

There is a staff member on duty every day if your child needs someone to talk to, and we also have a team of sixth form mentors who help out and encourage students. For anxious students or students with different needs, we also provide a safe, quiet place to relax and have some excellent books that students can borrow or use at their leisure.

You can find us in the Learning Zone, top floor of the Lancaster every lunchtime. During the exam period, we are open daily in B17.
