

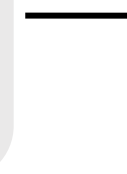

Define It

The word explicit describes something that is open and easy to see or understand.



Digging Deeper:

The explicit or obvious meanings might not always be the true meaning behind a text. For example, in a piece of satire, the writer may make an explicit argument that people should steal from the pockets of their neighbours when he is actually using this idea to mock the greed of local councils.

Draw It



Deconstruct It

From the Latin *explicitus*, meaning unobstructed.

Link It

Bias, agenda, political leanings, purpose, symbolism, semantics.



Use It
