

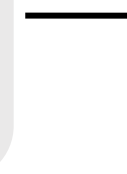

Define It

The word implicit describes something that is suggested, though not shown openly.



Digging Deeper:

Knowing the writer's intentions may help you draw on the implicit meanings or significance of the language used within a text. For example, if a writer is clearly biased towards a certain political agenda, the text is likely to feature a mixture of implicit and explicit criticism of any opposing views.

Draw It



Deconstruct It

From the Latin *implicatus*, meaning involved or entangled.

Link It

Writer's intentions, contextual factors, semantics, connotations, parody, satire, analogy.



Use It
