Consequence	Behaviour	Sanction
C1	-Disrupting the learning of others -Talking out of turn/arguing/out of seat -Uniform infringement -Missing kit (full kit or item of kit) – First occasion	Verbal Warning
C2	Repetition of C1 offence aside from kit	Second Verbal Warning
C3	-Missing kit (full kit or item of kit) – Second occasion (+message home to parents) -Third warning of C1 offence -More than 5 minutes late to a PE lesson -Chewing gum during a PE lesson or in a PE facility	15 Minute Teacher detention
C4	-Missing kit (full kit or item of kit) – Third occasion -Refusal to follow teacher instructions -Rudeness to a member of the PE department -Use of phone during a PE lesson (+ confiscation of phone) -Failure to attend teacher detention -Misbehaviour or speaking in a teacher detention -Swearing in a PE lesson (across the room or at another student)	30 Minute Curriculum Detention
C5	-Truancy a PE lesson -Walking away from a member of the PE department -Repetition of C4 offence -Deliberate defiance including refusing to take part in a PE lesson or borrow kit	House Detention
C6	-Bullying in PE -Fighting	Seclusion
