Dear parents/carers

Once again, thank you for your support of the school during this half term.

I am delighted that our examinations year groups have very nearly completed their assessments. We look forward to sharing well-earned results over the summer.

As the easing of lockdown progresses, we have been able to begin planning a number of extra-curricular activities, trips, etc. for the last half term of the year. Information on these will be shared with the students in due course.

As you are aware, the school has operated a surge testing unit on the school site this week. The unit has undertaken over 1000 tests for students and staff as part of local action against COVID. The results will be communicated back to you directly and to the school. Any positive test results will include instructions for self-isolation. Meanwhile, we would ask other members of your household to seek PCR tests if your postcode/household has been asked to by PHE.

When we return after half term, to help us continue to manage our COVID protocols, we have made some slight amendments to the structure of our day. Please check the timetable below for revised gates and arrival times. Timings for the end of the day remain unchanged.

## **Update for NW London on the vaccine programme and new variants**

### **Rise in new variants and the vaccine**

Across all NW London boroughs (Brent, Harrow, Hillingdon, Hounslow, Ealing, Hammersmith and Fulham, Kensington and Chelsea and Westminster) we are seeing a rise in the rates of new Covid-19 variants.

There is no evidence to suggest the Covid-19 vaccine is not working in terms of providing protection against variants, but it has never been more important to come forward for your first vaccine and ensure you have your second for maximum protection.

All our large vaccination centres listed below will be providing Pfizer vaccines from tomorrow.

Anyone over the age of 36 or can now book at [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) or walk-in to one of our vaccination centres for a first dose of the vaccine. GPs are also sending invites so you can book in.

Walk-in availability varies, booking guarantees you a slot, services are open 9am-7pm.

### **Walk-in vaccination services**

The vaccination centres providing a walk-in service for first doses are open from 9am to 7pm daily (except Byron Hall and Brentford leisure centre - see below). Full details [are here](#)

You are asked to bring ID, your name and address and your NHS number if you have it (if you don't have your NHS number you can still walk-in).

Following your walk-in you will then be able to book your second vaccine at 8 weeks 48 hours later using [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk)

### **Second doses**

To help ensure residents get the maximum protection possible, we are bringing forward the date of second vaccines from 12 weeks to 8 weeks.

If you had a vaccine at a GP service, you will be texted inviting you to attend a new date. If you attended a pharmacy or large vaccination centre and booked your second dose through the national booking system [www.nhs.uk](http://www.nhs.uk) – you will be texted to invite you to change your second appointment. You will need to cancel the appointment you have and rebook – there are plenty of appointments available to do this.
