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Invitation letter for parents of children aged 12 to 15 years of age

Dear parents/carers

COVID-19 vaccination for children aged 12 to 15 years of age

I am writing to inform you that we will soon be offering COVID-19 vaccinations in school. I would like to ask if you wish to give your consent for your child to receive a first dose of the vaccine.

This vaccination will be free of charge and our highest priority is making it easy for children to access one dose of the vaccine before the winter.

The main purpose of the COVID-19 school age vaccination programme is to provide protection to the children who receive the vaccine which may help to reduce transmission of COVID-19 in the wider population.

During the vaccination delivery we will maintain the range of measures we have in place to keep students safe from COVID-19.

Once we have your consent, we will schedule the vaccination appointment.

Please complete the consent form using the following link: <https://tinyurl.com/4auuc7b6>. Please also complete this if you do not wish your child to have the vaccine. By consenting you will be helping to play your part in reducing the risk of COVID-19 spreading.

At this stage, we are only seeking consent for students in years 7 to 11 who are over 12 years and over on the day of vaccination. This means that only children who have reached their 12th birthday at the time of vaccination will be eligible.
