### MOVING INTO SIXTH FORM

#### Helping you settle in

In Year 12, students are welcomed to the sixth form with a highly anticipated induction day. We also have an induction session on the first morning, during which, students receive their personalised timetables/study schedules; meet their tutors; form group; and gain insight into the ethos, atmosphere and procedures of the sixth form.

We encourage students to become independent at this stage in their school career, but also ensure that dedicated staff members are on hand to support when required. The head of KS5 and the heads of learning for year 12 and year 13 all provide individual attention and guidance.

We know that parental engagement is important to empower parents further in supporting our sixth form students, we hold a parental engagement evening in September and a study skills workshop in October. All events are publicised on the school calendar and website.

The school has close links with many universities, including Brunel and Bucks New. Students are encouraged and supported in applying to a range of universities including Russell Group and Oxbridge and undertake a comprehensive university orientation programme during their time with sixth form.

To make sure that students choose the right further education course or career for them, they are given constant access to careers, education, information and guidance. As a result, they are able to make well-informed decisions about their future choices.

Each student works alongside a personal development tutor, they have regular mentoring sessions, to discuss future options and for many, planning their university (UCAS) entry. There are regular visiting speakers from universities and trips to support this process.





### OUR SIXTH FORM CENTRE

#### State of the art facilities

The Lancaster building was designed in consultation with students and staff and our provision for business studies, maths and post-16 study in the building are second to none. Purpose-built learning spaces go beyond traditional concepts.

The innovative facilities inspire students at all levels. State-of-the-art technology and bright airy spaces make learning practical, accessible and comfortable. Students have the opportunity for both independent and group study in a calm, university-styled atmosphere.

There is open wi-fi throughout the building and the post-16 cafe is open all day, serving contemporary refreshments that will appeal to all.

Students can further develop their skills for the future by participating in a wide range of in-school activities. These include mentoring younger students, going on trips, running the student council and organising social and charity fundraising events. The post-16 senior student team includes head and deputy students and the team assumes a high level of responsibility and profile within the school.

Various events are organised throughout the academic year, including voluntary experiences; mentoring of primary school students; short cruises; paint balling; mountaineering; the Duke of Edinburgh award and various trips in the UK and abroad. The year is always concluded with our annual leavers' event, which is the highlight of the social calendar and allows the staff and continuing students to say farewell and good luck to our Year 13 students.
