Crime and Punishment Final Theme Paper 2 preparation and Mock Exams

Oct-Dec – students will gain their knowledge and understanding on the final theme this term. They will also be preparing for their mock exams this term and master their exam skills, understanding command words and evaluating controversial statements, forming arguments and using scriptures as supporting evidence.

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Peace and Conflict Theme- Paper 2 preparation

Sept-Oct- students will continue with their paper preparation and learn about the third theme this term. They will make reference to Christianity, Islam, non-religious views as well as British contemporary attitudes. Students will be assessed every mid-term and end of term.

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Mock Exams and Relationships & Families Theme – Paper 2 preparation

June-July –students will be revisiting paper one units and prepare for their mock exams. They will cover their second unit and make reference to Christianity, Islam, non-religious views as well as British contemporary attitudes. Students will be assessed every mid-term and end of term.

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Religion and Life Theme – Paper 2 preparation

April-May – students will be moving on to prepare for their paper 2 exam. They will cover the unit Religion and Life. They will make reference to Christianity, Islam, non-religious views as well as British contemporary attitudes. Students will be assessed every mid-term and end of term.

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Muslim Beliefs, Teachings and Practices unit – Paper 1 preparation

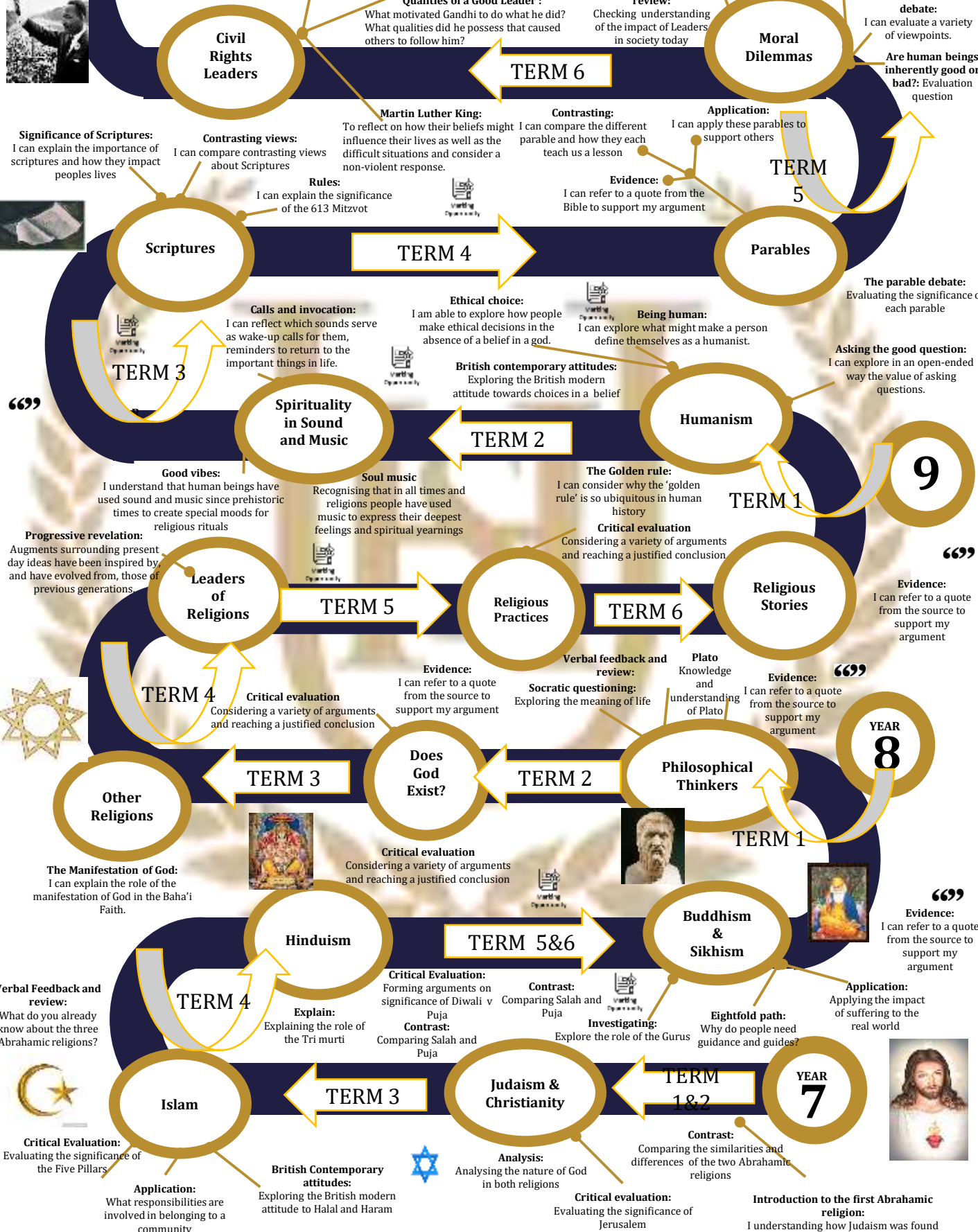
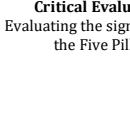
