MOVING INTO SIXTH FORM: *Starting Strong, Settling In*

Year 12 students are welcomed into Sixth Form with an engaging induction day and a session on their first morning, where they receive personalised timetables, meet their tutors and form group, and learn about the ethos and procedures of Sixth Form life. We promote independence at this stage, with dedicated staff, including the Head of Learning, offering individual guidance and support.

We value parental engagement and host a parental evening and a study skills workshop early in the year, both detailed in our school calendar and website. Our strong links with universities such as Brunel and Bucks New, alongside a robust university orientation programme, support students in applying to a range of universities, including Russell Group and Oxbridge.

Students also benefit from a number of careers-related trips and have constant access to careers information and guidance, enabling them to make well-informed decisions about their next steps. Personal development tutors provide regular mentoring sessions to discuss future plans, including UCAS applications, and students benefit from visiting speakers and university trips throughout the year.

HOW TO APPLY

Where Plans Take Shape

We welcome applications from all students who share our commitment to ambition, respect, and excellence.

To apply for a place in our Sixth Form, please follow these steps:

APPLICATION PROCESS

- Complete the online application form, available on our website.
- Submit your application by the stated deadline.
- We will review your application and invite you to an interview to discuss your course choices and future aspirations.
- Offers are made based on the outcome of the interview and your predicted GCSE grades.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- A minimum of five GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including English and Maths.
- For A Level courses, you will usually need a grade 6 or above in the subject (or related subject) you wish to study.
- For BTEC and vocational courses, a grade 4 or above in relevant subjects is required.

Entry requirements may vary depending on the course, and we will discuss your options during your interview.

We encourage you to explore our subject areas and consider how your choices align with your career aspirations. Our team is here to provide guidance and support throughout the application process, ensuring you have all the information you need to make the right decision for your future.
